1. GRADES 6 AND 9 NOVEMBER TIME TABLE

- 1.1 See time table attached.
- 1.2 Starting time is 08:30, but due to the unique circumstances at different schools the examinations can be written between 08:00 and 14:00 as all learners are suppose to be at their schools for the duration of the school day.
- 1.3 An electronic copy of question papers, which are **password protected**, will be supplied to each school. Passwords will be released to principals via Sub district (SD GET Curriculum Coodinator) so that the papers can be printed and passwords to the memos will be released on the day the specific question paper is written. Schools who struggle to open and print question papers can collect a hard copy at the Sub District to duplicate it.
- 1.4 Principals are responsible for the security of all papers and to ensure the credibility of the examinations.
- 1.5 Sample moderation for GET Schools (i.e. Grade 3, 6, 9) will take place from 7 to 14 December 2017. Information on how scripts will be drawn from schools will follow later.

2. **GR. 10 AND 11 NOVEMBER TIME TABLES
COMMON EXAMINATION PAPERS FOR 2017**

All schools whose 2016 Grade 12 results were below 80% pass rate will be required to write common provincial papers during October/November 2017 for the following subjects listed in Table 1.

All schools whose 2016 Grade 12 pass rate was equal to or above 80% may set their own papers and time tables. If these schools wish to write the same common papers, the attached time table should be followed. Schools will be responsible for the time table and question papers for the subjects offered outside the subjects listed above. Subjects/Papers which are not commonly written should be fitted in when there is no common paper.

Grade 10 & 11 Mathematics, Physical Sciences and English First Additional Paper 3 are National Papers and is expected that all schools use these examination papers, the dates for these papers **cannot** be changed by the province, these papers will be moderated and performance will be analysed.

Passwords for Grade 10 and 11 will be released by 07:00 in the morning when the paper is written via email to the principals to allow time to print the question papers and the starting time has been shifted to 10:30 and 14:00. Learners are to be at schools in the morning to do revision before the examination commence.
