1. ADMISSION LETTERS FOR GRADE 12 NSC CANDIDATES

- 1.2. In extraordinary cases candidates may enter the examination room with a permission letter from the Examination Directorate indicating the subject and paper to be written. (A copy of the letter must be attached to the handwritten mark sheets).

- 1.4. Bar coded stickers for each candidate have been printed separately on sheets that will be included with the question papers and mark sheets in the sealed envelopes.
- 1.5. The Chief Invigilator must ensure that each candidate receive the correct sticker with his/her examination number on it.
- 1.6. Candidates must paste the sticker on BOOK ONE (top right corner).
- 1.7. The front page (cover) of each script must still be completed in full with a pen. (The sticker does not replace any of the information on the front page)
